As part of the celebrations for the 50th anniversary of French – Chinese diplomatic relations, the French Artist Association (Ateliers d'Art de France) have organized a series of exhibitions, the 'French Art Tour', running from November 20th until December 31st at three significant venues in Shanghai: Liuli China Museum, Tao Art Gallery and Lafayette Art & Design Center.



Through the works of more than 40 French artists, Chinese audiences will see the full spectrum of the rich contemporary French art world. The French Artist Association is a significant French professional art organization, a partner of the Paris Home Furnishing Decoration Exhibition (Maison&Objet), and has organised a number of events in museums and galleries across Paris.

The 'French Art Tour' is the first activity the association has held in China and over the course of six weeks over two hundred works the best contemporary French art will be exhibited.
